SUBJECT: FFY 2022 ESG and HOPWA Awards

DATE: October 7, 2022

This memorandum details FFY2022 awards under the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and Housing Opportunity for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Program. The broad purpose of these programs is to deliver housing support and related services to persons strictly defined as either: (1) "homeless" or "at-risk of homelessness," as defined in Federal regulations for the ESG program or as (2) "eligible persons" (low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS) as defined for the HOPWA program.

For this fiscal year, we received 189 requests for ESG funding totaling \$13.5 million. Of the requests, \$5.04 million in funding is being awarded to 123 projects. Funding for the ESG projects comes from either (1) federal ESG funds awarded to DCA or (2) the State Housing Trust Fund for the Homeless (HTF).

The HOPWA program received 12 applications requesting a total of more than \$4 million in funding. Twelve of these agencies are being awarded funding for the total amount more than \$4.83 million. Funding for the HOPWA program comes from HOPWA federal funds awarded to DCA. A summary of the funding awards is as follows:
