



HOME-ARP Supportive Service Agencies

The HOME-ARP Supportive Services program is designed to provide essential support to individuals and households who qualify. Under the HOME-ARP program, these services aim to enhance housing stability, promote self-sufficiency, and improve overall well-being. The HOME ARP Supportive Services program plays a crucial role in addressing the root causes of homelessness and housing insecurity. By providing holistic, person-centered services, the program strengthens communities and fosters long-term stability for individuals and families in need.

Those who qualify include: 1. Homeless, as defined in [24 CFR 91.5](#); 2. At risk of homelessness as defined in [24 CFR 91.5](#); 3. Fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking; 4. Other populations who require services or housing assistance to prevent homelessness, or those at greatest risk of housing instability.

Each agency *MAY* be able to provide one or more of the following supportive services (related to housing stability) for eligible households.

Housing-Related Services

- Housing search and counseling
- Housing application assistance
- Tenant counseling and legal services related to housing
- Security and utility deposits
- Rent and Utility payments for qualifying households
- Moving assistance

Case Management

- Assessment of service needs
- Connecting to mainstream benefits (e.g., SSI, TANF, SNAP)
- Coordinating medical, mental health, and substance use treatment
- Developing individualized housing and service plans

General Life Skill Services and Supports

- Outpatient health services
- Behavioral health services (mental health/substance use)
- Life skills training
- Employment assistance and job training
- Education services (GED, literacy, etc.)
- Childcare assistance
- Transportation assistance (bus tokens, mileage reimbursements)

Legal Services

- Eviction prevention and landlord/tenant mediation
- Assistance with lease compliance
- Representation in housing-related court proceedings

Other Eligible Costs

- Services to help individuals regain identification
- Acquisition of personal documents necessary for housing
- Coordination of service delivery
- Staff salaries and benefits directly related to service provision
- Reasonable administrative costs (within allowable limits)

The activities listed below are ineligible expenses according to [HUD Notice CPD-21-10](#) and cannot be reimbursed by HOME-ARP funding. However, some agencies may have other funding available to cover these needs.

- General food assistance not tied to housing stability
- Direct cash assistance or gift cards (unless for eligible transportation or utility payments)
- Entertainment, recreation, or non-essential events
- Furniture not necessary for move-in (e.g., decorative items)
- Medical treatment or prescriptions not related to housing stability
- Costs for services not tied to eligible QPs
- Capital improvements or building repairs
- Duplication of benefits (e.g., if already covered by another source)
- Marketing or outreach unrelated to services
- General program operations not linked to specific service delivery
