Short-Term Work Program Update 2012-2016

Prepared by the CSRA Regional Commission June, 2011

Project Background

In 2008, the Hancock County prepared and adopted a "partial" update of the County's *Comprehensive Plan* in accordance with the recertification schedule established by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA). According to the recertification schedule, Hancock County is required to have a full update of their Comprehensive Plan prepared and adopted by June 30, 2011. In February of 2001 DCA offered local governments with upcoming recertification dates the option of updating *their Short-Term Work Program* (STWP) in lieu of preparing a full update. The "deferral option" was initiated to as a way for local governments to continue to work towards the implementation of their existing Comprehensive Plans while working with increasingly limited financial resources.

After consideration Hancock County decided that taking advantage of the deferral option would be in their best interest. Their reason for this decision was based on current budget constraints and the fact that the existing Comprehensive Plan remains relevant.

Hancock County held the required public hearing for the STWP Update on July 12, 2011 for the purposes of obtaining public comment on the draft STWP. Following the Public Hearing the Board of Commissioners approved a resolution to officially transmit the draft STWP to the Central Savannah River Area Regional Commission and DCA for review. A copy of the transmittal resolution is included in the Appendix of this submittal.
