RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Georgia Planning Act of 1989 requires all local governments in Georgia to prepare a comprehensive plan; including a Short Term Work Program at least every five years; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs has established Minimum Standards and Procedures under the Georgia Planning Act of 1989 for coordinated and comprehensive planning, including standards and procedures for the preparation of local comprehensive plans and implementation thereof, community involvement, coordinated review, and preparation of work program updates; and
