
**WHEREAS**, the City of Barnesville has completed a 2014-2019 Update to the Short-Term Work Program for its Comprehensive Plan; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Barnesville's 2014-2019 STWP Update has been officially approved by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs;
