WHEREAS, Butts County 2025 Comprehensive Plan has held the required number of public hearings and has otherwise complied with the requirements of said Georgia Comprehensive Planning Act of 1989;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Butts County herewith adopt the 2012-2016 Short Term Work Program (STWP) and incorporate these changes into the Butts County 2025 Comprehensive Plan on this, the  $3^{\circ}$  day of February, 2012.
