Kick Off-Public Information Meetings	PowerPoint presentation at initial public meeting covering the project purpose and general plan approach.
Printed Information	Printed newspaper articles and posted notices
Mailing Lists	Chamber of Commerce mailing list supplemented with other addresses; 100+ e-mail and physical address contacts
