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The Details of each of the 2013-2017 projects are as follows:

1. Wastewater Pond Upgrades – This project was started this year and should be completed by the end of the year. This project was financed by use of a loan from Madison Co. BOE as part of the new IGA signed by both BOE & the City as to the lease and ownership of the current wastewater pond. In this agreement certain upgrades were agreed upon in order to maintain compliance with EPD.
2. Implement of FOG (oil & grease) Control Program- This project was implemented during 2013. The implementation of this program has proven to be a success. The EPD violations have been drastically reduced since the implementation. This program requires all businesses who handle food preparation to have a working grease trap. Size and maintenance of the grease trap is based on the number of available seating of each business. All businesses required to have a grease trap must maintain the system as stated in the City's ordinance and submit regular manifest of the maintenance.
3. Implement Fire Flow Availability – The project was implemented during the latter half of 2013. It has been put in place to charge users who have fire water risers that feed sprinkler systems. The rate plan was based on the Madison Co. IDA schedule. This program was needed to provide the city with adequate funding to maintain its infrastructure of fire needs.
4. South Tank Project/100,000 gal Water Tank – This project is underway and should be completed by Fall 2014. This project consists of the purchase of a used water tank to be placed on the South side of the city (proposed site at this time – Ag Center located at Madison St/Hope Thompson) to better serve the citizens living on the South side of town. With this project the city would be assured of having plenty of water for its citizens. After the fall of the old tank (located where Chicken Express now sits), the new tank was placed at Northridge. This caused a flow problem to the residents living on the south side of town, since the piping now ran opposite of what it did when connected to the old site. The citizens on the south side have experienced low water pressure since that time. This project also will ensure the city's volunteer fire department of adequate fire flow pressure all over the city. Giving the citizens of Danielsville an even better ISO rating for their insurance needs.
5. Super Well Water Supply Supplement – This goes hand-in-hand with the South Tank Project. The City and the Madison Co. BOE will enter into an IGA for the use of a well located at the MCHS, currently being used to irrigate the ball fields. Again, this project should be completed by Fall 2014.
6. Intersection Improvements @ Hwy 29 & 98/Round-a-bout – This project is planned to begin in

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2014. It has been discussed for some time now. The city has been working with the GA DOT & GA Power during the discussion period to ensure that the citizens will get the improvements needed that best suits the needs of its citizens as a whole. This intersection has grown to be very dangerous, since an estimated 15,000 vehicles pass through it daily.

7. Renovate Existing, Aged Water & Sewer Lines – This is listed as a future project for the city, with hopes to begin in 2015. Most of the lines are 40+ years old and the ones coming from the Northridge Tank need to be sized accordingly to provide better flow. With aged lines, the maintenance of those lines becomes much more costly to maintain. It will save money in the long term to renovate these lines. The city plans to use its SPLOST revenues to begin accomplishing this project.
8. Safe Routes To School – This is also listed as a future project for the city. This project would consist of renovating existing sidewalks and installing some new sidewalks and installing new lighting along the city's downtown area of Courthouse Sq. down to Madison St where 3 of the county's existing schools are located and where a future Career Center is being built. It has been discussed with NEGRC previously, and their staff has designed a starting plan. The NEGRC will continue to work on obtaining special grant funding for this project.
