




Parties: Fannin County and the Cities of Blue Ridge, McCaysville, and Morganton

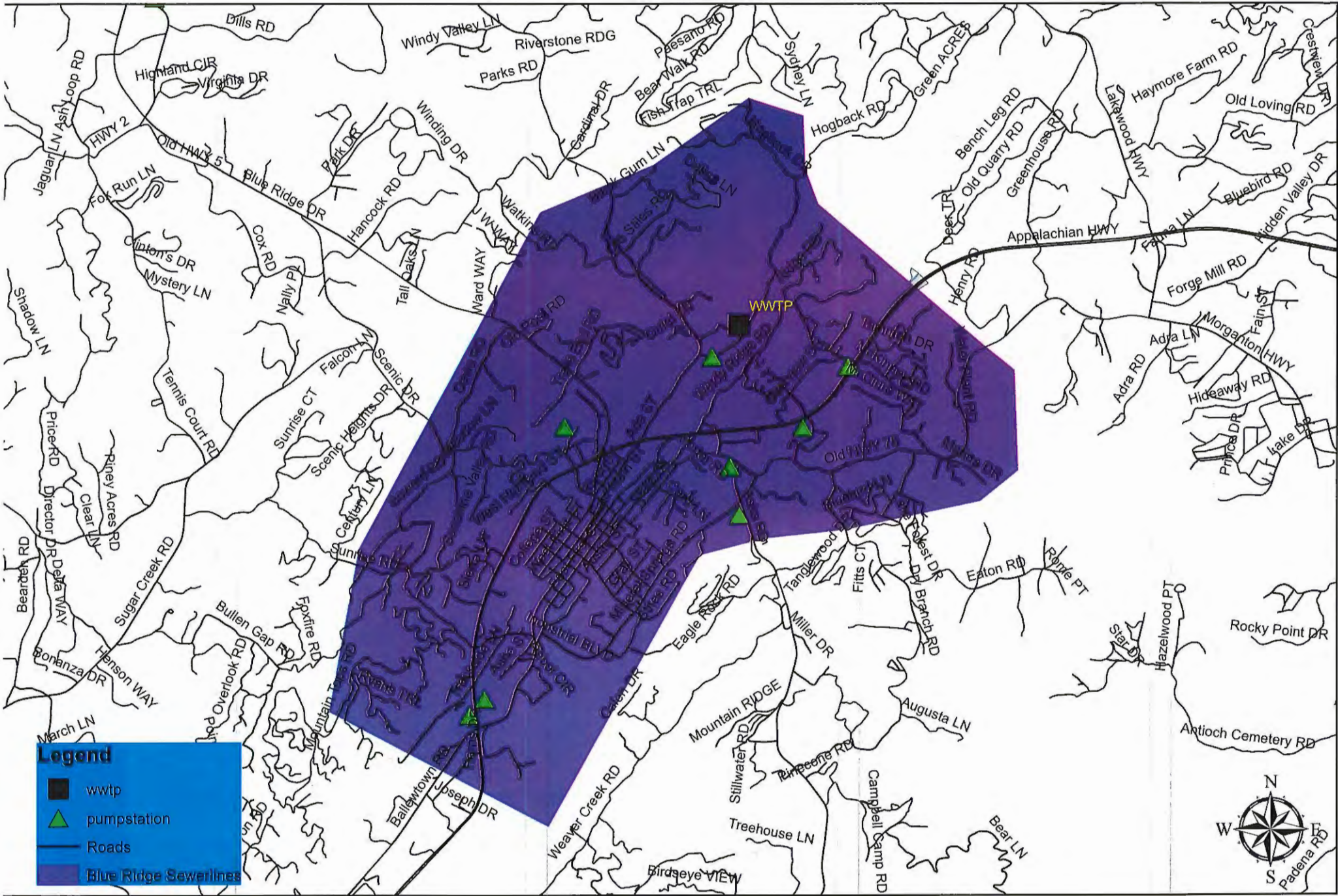
