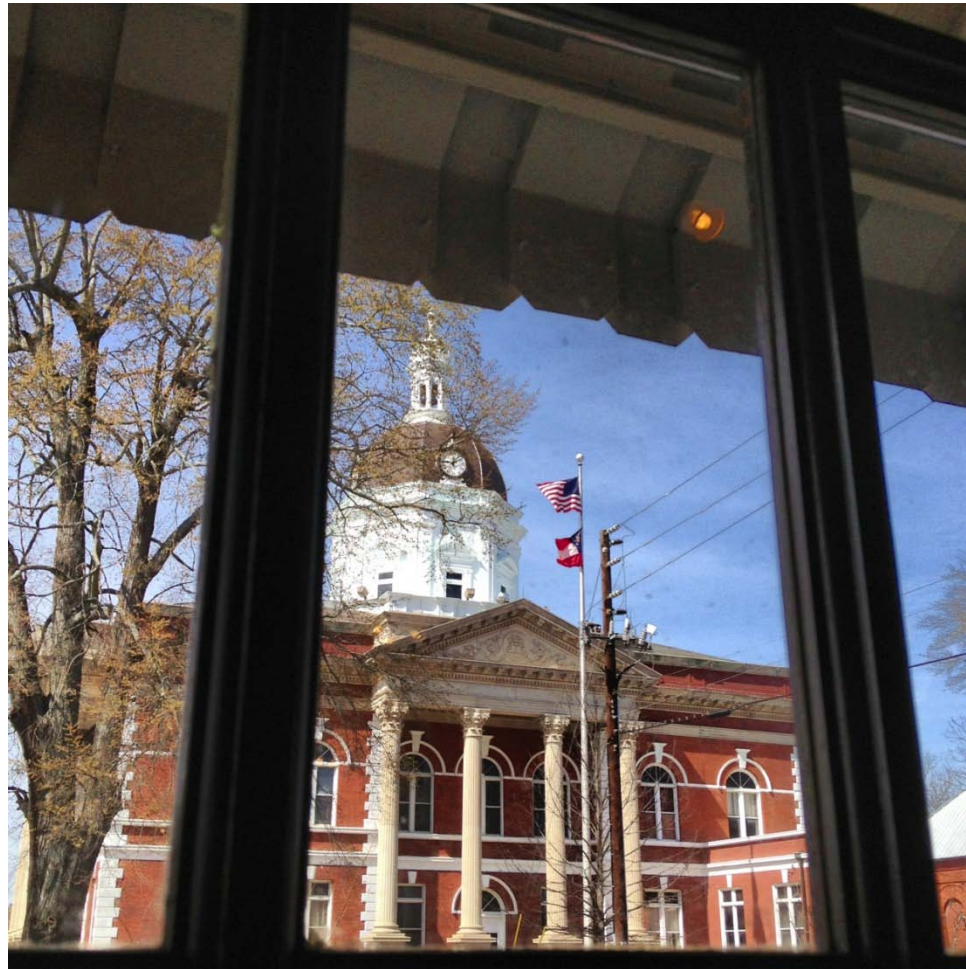


WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on May 2nd at 5:00 PM at the City of Greenville City Hall; and
