A RESOLUTION ADOPTING IN PART A REVISED WATER SUPPLY COMPONENT OF THE OVERALL CITY OF DAHLONEGA AND LUMPKIN COUNTY SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGY THEREBY AMENDING THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT DATED DECEMBER 1, 1999

Be it resolved by the City Council of Dahlonega and it is so ordained by the authority thereof that:

Whereas, the City of Dahlonega is in the process of renegotiating its Service Delivery Strategy ("Agreement") with Lumpkin County; and

Whereas, in order to retain its Qualified Local Government status and for other reasons, it is necessary that a portion of the existing Service Delivery Agreement be amended and revised immediately; and

Whereas, the portion which must be amended and revised is identified in the original Agreement dated December 1, 1999, as the "Water Supply" section; and

Whereas, on an interim basis the City of Dahlonega and Lumpkin County have agreed to terms regarding an amendment to the original 1999 Agreement regarding the component labeled "Water Supply," and the terms of that interim agreement are specified on Exhibit A attached hereto:

Therefore, the information contained in Exhibit A is hereby accepted and approved as an amendment to the Service Delivery Agreement between the City of Dahlonega and Lumpkin County dated December 1, 1999, until such time as the negotiations between the City and County are completed regarding a new Service Delivery Strategy between the City of Dahlonega and Lumpkin County as required by law and the rules of the State of Georgia Department of Community Affairs.

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE LUMPKIN COUNTY – CITY OF DAHLONEGA SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGY

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County entered into an agreement with the City of Dahlonega for Strategic Delivery of Services with the intent to avoid unnecessary duplication of services common to both city and county; and

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County and the City of Dahlonega now desire to jointly amend the service delivery areas for water and sewer service for the mutual benefit of the two governments;

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved that the Lumpkin County – City of Dahlonega Service Delivery Strategy is hereby amended as follows:

Each party hereto shall have the right, power, license and privilege to be the sole public provider of water and sewer in accordance with the "Service Delivery Strategy Summary of Service Delivery Arrangements - Sewer" prepared August 2, 2004, and the "Service Delivery Strategy Summary of Service Delivery Arrangements - Water" prepared August 2, 2004, within the respective areas set out on the Lumpkin County / City of Dahlonega Service Delivery Area map adopted August 2, 2004, and signed by the Lumpkin County Commissioner as governing authority of Lumpkin County and by the Mayor of Dahlonega under authority and direction of the Dahlonega City Council of even date, and upon execution of the Service Delivery Strategy Update Certification of even date.

The City shall have the right to provide water and sewer service, or to issue subordinate rights and licenses as it might see fit, for that area within the City of Dahlonega corporate limits and the surrounding area within the area established on the above referenced map.

Lumpkin County shall have the right to provide water and sewer service, or to issue subordinate rights and licenses as its governing authority might see fit, for that area within the County boundaries and outside the area set aside for the City of Dahlonega on the above referenced map. It is further acknowledged and accepted that the Lumpkin County Water and Sewerage Authority is the primary provider of water and sewerage service outside the City of Dahlonega service area.

This agreement is contingent on the adoption of the City of Dahlonega, of even date, of the above referenced delivery strategy summaries, the map and the update certification without further amendment or limitation.

Resolved and adopted this 2nd day of August, 2004, and effective upon the adoption by the City of Dahlonega.


