ADOPTION RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, the Georgia Planning Act of 1989 enacted by the Georgia General Assembly mandated that each of Georgia's 159 counties and cities prepare a Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, Randolph County prepared the required Comprehensive Plan Update Report of Accomplishment and 5-year Update of its Short Term Work Program; and

WHEREAS, by this resolution, Randolph County certifies that the plan update was reviewed by the River Valley Regional Commission and the Georgia Department of Community Affairs and found to be in compliance with the Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Plans; and
