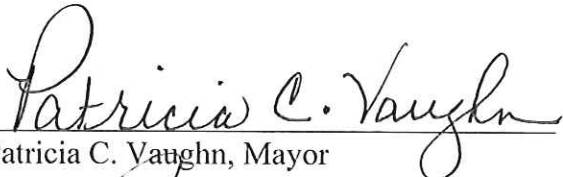
WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (“City”) has prepared an annual update to its Capital Improvement Element (“CIE”) and the Short Term Work Program (“STWP”) of its Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, the annual update of the CIE and STWP was prepared in accordance with the Development Impact Fee Compliance Requirements and the Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning established by the Georgia Planning Act of 1989, as amended, and a Public Hearing was held on October 1, 2012;

WHEREAS, the annual update was transmitted to and approved by the Atlanta Regional Commission and the Georgia Department of Community Affairs as evidenced by letter dated November 2, 2012;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs do hereby adopt the annual update of the Capital Improvements Element and Short Term Work Program covering the five-year period 2012-2017, as per the requirements of the Georgia Planning Act of 1989, as amended.
