WHEREAS, the Service Delivery Strategy must be officially adopted and verified by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs by the community's recertification date to retain Oualified Local Government (QLG) status; and

WHEREAS, Twiggs County and the cities of Allentown, Danville and Jeffersonville adopted the original Service Delivery Strategy in 2000 identifying Twiggs County as a future service provider for water and sewerage; and

WHEREAS, Twiggs County endeavors to provide water and sewer service to unserved areas of the County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Twiggs County Board of Commissioners that the attached Twiggs County Service Delivery Strategy is hereby amended for the services of water and sewerage to identify Twiggs County Board of Commissioners as a current provider of these services in the areas identified on the map indicating the service area; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Twiggs County Board of Commissioners is herby authorized to place the Service Delivery Strategy on the appropriate forms prescribed by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs, to execute those forms in the proper places, and to submit the Service Delivery Strategy to the Department of Community Affairs for verification in compliance with O.C.G.A. 36-70-26.
