GEORGIA STATE MINIMUM STANDARD SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE (INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE WITH GEORGIA STATE AMENDMENTS)

The INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE, 2012 Edition, published by the International Code Council, when used in conjunction with these and any other Georgia State Amendments to the INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE, 2012 EDITION, shall constitute the official *Georgia State Minimum Standard Swimming Pool and Spa Code*.

GEORGIA STATE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS

The State's minimum requirements for public swimming pools shall be in accordance with O.C.G.A. 31-45-13 and the Rules and Regulations of the Georgia Department of Public Health and this code. Contact the County Health Department for any local rules and regulations governing public swimming pools in effect on or after December 31, 2000.

GEORGIA STATE AMENDMENTS

CODE REFERENCE:

(a) Replace all references to the ICC *Electrical Code* with references to the *Georgia State Minimum Standard Electrical Code* (*National Electrical Code with Georgia State Amendments*).

*Revise the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code, 2012 Edition, as follows:

CHAPTER 3 GENERAL COMPLIANCE

SECTION 304 FLOOD HAZARD AREAS

*Delete Section 304 'Flood Hazard Areas' in its entirety without substitution. (Effective January 1, 2014)

CHAPTER 7 ONGROUND STORABLE RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOLS

SECTION 702 LADDERS AND STAIRS

*Delete Figure 702.2 and last sentence of Section 702.2 'Type A and Type B ladders'.
