TO THE
2015 INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE TASK FORCE

The 2015 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) Task Force is charged with assessing the differences between the 2009 IECC with Georgia Supplements and Amendments (existing code) and the 2015 IECC, and making recommendations regarding its adoption and any necessary supplements and amendments to the State Codes Advisory Committee (SCAC). The task force is also responsible for providing a recommendation on the adoption of ASHRAE 90.1-2013.

The task force will be expected to give a preliminary progress/status report to the SCAC at the April 13, 2017 SCAC meeting and its final report to the SCAC at the June 22, 2017 meeting.

The approval of new supplements and amendments and the carrying forward of existing supplements and amendments should be done conservatively, in order that supplements and amendments be limited to only those which the task force deems necessary to the betterment of the code.

The tentative effective date for the 2015 IECC and ASHRAE 90.1-2013 with any necessary supplements and amendments is January 1, 2018.
